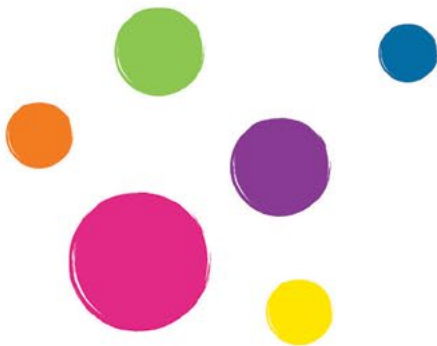

➤➤ Even from the womb, babies begin learning the languages spoken by those closest to them. Up to the age of 4-6 months, children are open to all the sounds in the world. From then on, they start to narrow it down to the sounds of their mother tongue(s).

Repeated background hearing is the fundamental core that the Helen Doron English method is built upon. Hearing our audio material at home allows a child to effortlessly soak up the sounds, rhythms, and patterns of the language.

The child's attention naturally shifts back and forth between the audio material and what is happening in the room. It doesn't matter that the child does not initially understand the meaning of the words.

Gradually, over time, the meaning unfolds as the same songs are repeated in the lessons with the teacher, who uses games, props and physical activities to underscore meaning and help the child make those connections. Once understood, this content becomes the basis for building more comprehension.



Helen Doron Stream features fun, constantly updated, and exciting video episodes, songs, and audio, essential to reinforcing language-learning skills. When listened to at home, in the background—the sounds and rhythm of the language are absorbed naturally during daily activities, providing the ongoing exposure to English that is key to the Helen Doron English methodology.
